



Admission Process

Autism Career Training provides services that promote independence, social skill development, and vocational skills to assist adults with autism reach their potential. Our admission process is outlined below.

1 ACT Application

After the family has completed the application form, a staff member will set up a phone call within 2 business days to discuss our program and the families' needs. Staff will determine if the trainee applicant can move to the next step on coming in for a tour.

2 Tour/Submit Documents

An ACT staff member will schedule the tour and forward additional documents for submission. Tours can take place between 9-3 on Monday-Friday. An ACT staff member may request additional information or an additional meeting prior to the determination on a trial period.

3 Trial Period

ACT staff will set up the initial session and will remain in communication with family as to how things are progressing. The staff will set up an initial schedule for the trial period based on progress. The trial period may take up to 30 days, based on the situation.

4 Decision on Enrollment

Based on assessment and observation by the teachers and other staff members, the Executive Director will make a determination on if our a program is a fit. The Executive Director or Clinical Director will set up a final meeting with guardian(s) to go over the trainee's schedule.
