Job Description:

The BCBA will be responsible for providing high-quality applied behavior analysis (ABA) services to trainees, including assessment, treatment planning, and ongoing evaluation. The BCBA will also play a key role in the development and support of our ABA program.

Responsibilities:

- Conduct functional behavior assessments (FBAs) and oversee the onboarding of new ABA trainees.
- Perform reassessments and manage reauthorizations for all trainees.
- Manage authorizations and maintain communication with relevant stakeholders.
- Provide support in emergency behavioral situations, potentially floating between locations as needed.
- Demonstrate flexibility and provide support at either location when challenging behaviors arise.
- Conduct weekly 1:1 meetings with the behavioral team.

- Provide professional development and training on behavioral de-escalation strategies.
- Serve as the Central Reach coordinator.
- Manage weekly scheduling for Registered Behavior Technicians (RBTs).
- Lead the development of assessments and contribute to the overall growth of the ABA program.
- Develop individualized treatment plans.
- Design, implement, and adjust behavior intervention plans as needed.
- Modify and adjust treatment plans based on trainee progress.
- Maintain BCBA certification and complete required continuing education units (CEUs).
